

WELCOME TO SUMMER CAMP!

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are looking forward to summer camp 2020. The weather is warming up and we are ready to begin having some outdoor fun! We will be making new friends while adjusting to our surroundings. The classroom groups will form on June 15th and stay the same. Older student classrooms can have 15 children and younger 2 year old classroom, will have 12 children.

ITEMS THAT SHOULD BE BROUGHT

- ★ A toothbrush (non-electric) and toothpaste and a change of clothes. Please label with child's name.
- ★ Proper safety shoes (gym shoes) need to be worn at all times. Please remember that a **separate pair** of gym shoes (for indoor use) needs to be left at AALE.
- ★ Updated Medical, Application, Emergency Card, DCFS Licensing Standards, Guidance & Discipline.
- ★ Please note that DCFS will be requiring that all student files have proof of hearing and vision screenings, as well as a copy of their birth certificate. Your child's doctor can also write a note stating that he/she does not have any concerns regarding hearing and vision at this time; this note will also suffice.
- ★ If you would like your child to wear a mask in the classroom, please provide a mask with their name on it. We understand that most families have a preference on masks and have provided them already. If you need us to supply a mask, please let us know.
- ★ A folder and backpack for your child's daily work, projects, daily sheets.

ITEMS THAT SHOULD NOT BE BROUGHT TO CAMP

- ★ Breakfast, snacks, and lunch will be provided for your child. All other food must be left at home. This prevents problems with other children and any possible food allergies. If your child is celebrating a special day, non-edible treats can be given to the children. Please email the office for more ideas.
- ★ As a safety precaution, all jewelry (necklaces, earrings, rings, etc.) must be left at home.
- ★ All toys should be left at home.
- ★ A letter about our Sunblock Policy is also attached.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- ★ Tuition payments are due every Friday. Please see our handbook for our tuition policies.
- ★ If your child has any allergies, please be sure to inform the office.
- ★ To keep you informed, a calendar consisting of daily themes and activities, will be sent home. Each week will have a different theme.
- ★ Please remember that **ALL** parents are required to wear a face mask at the front door, when picking up and dropping off their child.
- ★ Blue All Aboard lunch bags will not be needed this summer.
- ★ Please be sure that all children arrive no later than 9:00 a.m. This will help with scheduling staff at our front door. However, we are aware that sometimes situations arise that are out of your control. We are also aware that children may arrive late from time to time due to doctor's appointments.
- ★ When dropping off and picking up, please be sure that your child is not utilizing the playground areas. We have designated these areas to use each day in order to make sure they are properly sanitized.
